WE'RE FIGHTING FOR

A restorative 15% pay rise

- The average nurse's pay has fallen by over 20% since 2010 which has contributed to over 45,000 vacancies - a pay rise keeps our patients safe by encouraging staff to return
- This Government have spent £37 billion on track and trace it doesn't even work - a 15% pay rise would cost 1/7 of that & create jobs within our local economy
