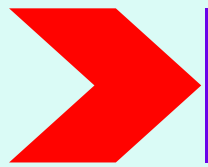

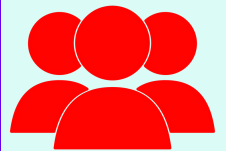
WE'RE FIGHTING FOR



A restorative 15% pay rise

- ➡ The average nurse's pay has fallen by **over 20% since 2010** which has **contributed to over 45,000 vacancies** - a pay rise keeps our patients safe by encouraging staff to return
- ➡ This Government have spent £37 billion on track and trace - it doesn't even work - **a 15% pay rise would cost 1/7 of that** & create jobs within our local economy

Safety at work



- ➡ We believe that our workplaces need to be safe for ourselves and our patients
- ➡ One element of this is our fight for adequate PPE - the UK does not provide the standard of PPE that the World Health Organisation (WHO) recommends

An Anti-racist NHS

- ➡ Even before the pandemic, **Nurses of Colour** were subject to racism on an institutional & individual level
- ➡ During the pandemic, this resulted in over **70% of the nurses who died from COVID-19 being Nurses of Colour**
