YOU NEED A PAY RISE

- ➡ The average nurse's pay has fallen by **over 20% since 2010** which **has contributed to over 45,000 vacancies** - a pay rise keeps your patients safe by encouraging staff to return
- ➡ This Government have spent £37 billion on track and trace - it doesn't even work - **a 15% pay rise would cost 1/7 of that** & create jobs within our local economy


WHAT YOU CAN DO

It takes **50%** of all NHS members in a union to vote and **40%** of all NHS members in a union to vote yes to pass a ballot for industrial action, including "work to rule". So you need to:

- ➡ VOTE in your union ballot, update your details & get the rest of your team to do the same
- ➡ Start contacting other wards/teams & create a Whatsapp group to link yourselves up
- ➡ Join Nurses United - we build power together & offer loads of resources & support to get active
- ➡ Attend any activist training your union is offering & become a rep
